




Draw a wavy line near the bottom of the paper for sand. Draw a short horizontal line in the middle of the paper.




Add a "castle line" to connect the top of the castle. Add castle lines out from each side of the castle.




Add a curved line to one side of each of the doors.

Add short "sticks" on each castle top and add a triangle flag.


Draw a horizon line behind the castle.



Draw lines from the ends of the horizontal line down to the sand.
Add two vertical lines up from top of the sandcastle.




Draw vertical lines down to form the sides of the castle. Add three upsidedown "U" doors.



Add details such as: shovel, starfish, shell, sunglasses, sun, clouds, fish, beach ball, etc.




On the right side of the paper, draw a large "U" shape that starts high and ends about halfway up the paper.




Connect the ends of the "U" with a slightly curved line. This creates a crescent shape.




Draw a curved line across the end of the crescent for the horn. Add ears, an eye and a mouth. 4



Add a second horn near the middle of the head. Draw a curve from the ears towards the paper's bottom corner.

Draw four legs.

Add a tail and bumpy-line toenails.

How to Draw a Frog







Start in the middle of the paper!




1. Draw two circles for eyes, then add two smaller circles inside the larger circles. Just below the eyes, draw two legs with webbed feet. (I tell the kids to draw two straight lines, then join them together on the bottom to make one leg.)



2. To make the body, draw a half circle from the left eye to the left leg. Then a half circle from the right eye to the right leg. Add a small line inbetween the legs to connect the body.




3. Start a curved line 3/4 up the side of the body, and draw down to the bottom of the frog. Repeat on the other side to add the legs of the frog.




4. Add webbed feet, a lily pad, mouth, tongue, and spots for your frog. You can also add a delicious bug or two if you'd like.



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


PARTS OF A CASTLE




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
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
Draw a small circle in the center of the paper.



Add "C" shapes around the circle. Continue building the succulent outward by adding additional "C" shapes.




Continue adding "C" shapes until the succulent is large and round.



Add a long, skinny rectangle under the succulent. The top of the rectangle may be "behind" the

succulent. Add two vertical lines and connect them at the bottom to make the pot.




Draw a curved line out of the pot.

make a thick stem.




For the cactus, draw a large upside-down "U." Stack smaller "U's" on top of the base.

Add "X's" on the cactus for its spines. Draw a pattern on the pot. Add additional plants if desired.







1. Draw a dot somewhere on your paper. Because I want my picture vertical, I'm centering the dot (eye) near the middle/top.





Mouth: Draw a vertical line in front of the eye. The eye is near the top of the line. Now, draw a line perpendicular to the vertical line.. This is the center of the beak. To make a closed beak, draw a curved line on top and one on the bottom.




2. After deciding the type of beak (opened or closed), draw a line from the bottom of the beak downwards (like a letter "J") Draw a line for the head.











Here's a tip for drawing leaves: start with the stem first. Make it straight or curved, then add the leaf.





*Grid fits a standard playing card: 2.5" x 3.5"


