2. Drive slowly to keep students and other drivers safe.
3. Use the circle or front parking lot to drop off or pick up students.
4. Be mindful of the bus loading zone, and ensure there is space for the bus to exit.

Lunch Program

ALL students at PBCCS are eligible for free breakfast and lunch through CCSD Nutrition Services. Students will learn about the breakfast and lunch procedures on the first day of school.

Required Health and Safety Protocols

PBCCS asks that all students and families be respectful of the required health and safety protocols, so that we can keep the doors open and continue to educate our students in-person.

Mask Requirements

- *Masks required:* Indoors and on school buses
- *Masks optional:* Outside recess, during lunch & snack, outdoor classes & activities
- *Mask exceptions:* Accommodations, such as a face shield, are limited for legitimate medical reasons or because of a known and documented disability. There are no religious exemptions for masks at this time. 504 and IEP plans are meant for students with documented disabilities.
- *Enforcement:* PBCCS staff will continually extend patience and grace when reminding students about the mask requirement. We will not be punitive in our response, however schools are unable to make exceptions.
- ***Schools cannot serve a student in-person if they or their family choose not to wear a face covering.*** If masking is not an option for your student and/or family, [Grizzly Mountain HomeLink](#) is a great option. Vaccine Requirements

- All K-12 public and private school teachers, educators, support staff, and volunteers are required to be fully vaccinated against COVID-19 by October 18, or six weeks from FDA approval, whichever is later.
- **At this time, the COVID-19 vaccine is NOT required for students to attend school.**

Other Protocols

- Daily cleaning and sanitation of school and classrooms.
- Hand washing and sanitizing throughout the school day.
- Less restrictive cohorting – allowing students more interaction with peers, small group activities, and mixed-grade activities.
- Quarantining for students and staff with COVID-19 symptoms, or who test positive, regardless of vaccination status.
- Less restrictive quarantine rules for students and staff exposed to a COVID-19 (provided students are wearing masks) and those that are vaccinated.
- COVID-19 testing will be available to students and staff if exposed at school. PBCCS will NEVER test a student for COVID-19 without parent permission.
