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## Dress Code Reminders

As the weather gets warmer it is important for our students to dress appropriately for learning. In keeping with the goal to establish a positive learning environment for all students, the following dress guidelines are in place:

- Hats/Headwear: Hats, hoods and headwear must be taken off in the building. Exceptions may be made by the administrator.
- Shoes must be worn at all times at school.
  - Grades K-5: Close toed shoes must be worn at school. Open-toed shoes, such as flip-flops are not permitted, for safety purposes.
  - Grades 6-8: Open-toed shoes are permitted during the school day.
  - P.E. shoes are required for participation in P.E. activities in all grades.
- Clothing:
  - Logos must be safe, responsible and respectful.
  - Shorts must be as long or longer than the tips of the student's fingers when arms hang naturally at the sides. Spandex shorts are not appropriate at school.

- Clothing provides full coverage and undergarments must not be visible. Midriff crops, mesh and tube tops are not permitted.
- Tank tops with an approximately 2 inch shoulder strap are permitted at school.
