DROP- OFF DETAILS

(Student's Entry to School: Students will enter at the locations listed below. Each student will be greeted by a staff member, and go straight to their classrooms.

Grade Level: and Location:

Kindergarten, 1st and 4th Grades, Side Gate (Mrs. McGillivray)

2nd, 3rd and 5th Grades, Main Entrance (Mrs. Holbrook)

6th, 7th and 8th Grade, West Gate (Mr. Upp)

Bus Riders, Bus Gate/Bus Zone (Mrs. Choate)

END OF THE DAY PICK-UP DETAILS- 2:30

When dropping off and picking up in the circle, from Williams Road, turn right into the church parking lot. Drive all the way around the church to turn right into the circle for drop-off and pick-up. Please communicate with your child's teacher if you are carpooling or your child is being picked up by another family member or friend.

During drop off and pick up, please:

- Stay in your car. PBCCS staff members will be present to assist with student safety at drop off and pick up times.
- Drive slowly to keep students and other drivers safe.
- Use the circle or front parking lot to drop off or pick up students.
- Be mindful of the bus loading zone, and ensure there is space for the bus to exit.

PE HAPPENS DAILY!

PBCCS has a special grant which allows students to have PE every day. Kids will need PE shoes to change into.

MEALS (BREAKFAST & LUNCH)

Through Crook County Public Schools, PBCCS participates in the National School Lunch, School Breakfast, and Special Milk programs and offers meals which may be free or reduced, based on a student's financial need. Additional information can be obtained in our school's office.

Meal costs for lunches: \$3.75 (middle schoolers) and \$3.40 (elementary)

Meal costs for breakfasts are \$2.10 for all students K-8.

Milk costs are .50 cents (chocolate or plain milk)

To prepay for meals:

- Parents can deposit money in Easy School Pay on the Crook County School District Website.

- Each student will have a meal card where funds will be stored. As they purchase a meal, or milk, funds will be subtracted.
